

Sanitary Sewer leak Detection Testing Notification

Beginning on 8/25/2025, the Village of Moravia will be conducting leakage testing on the sanitary sewer system located within the Village. This test is being conducted as part of a study to locate and identify areas of ground and surface water entering the Sanitary Sewer System. This effort will help to reduce sanitary sewer flow volumes and operating costs at the Waste Water Treatment Facility. It is anticipated that this testing will take 4 days and end on 8/29/2025.

During the test, a non-toxic smoke will be blown into the sanitary sewer system to reveal leaks where storm water and surface waters may be entering the sewer. The smoke that is utilized for this testing is manufactured specifically for this purpose, and it leaves no residual odor or stains, and has no adverse affect on plants or animals. It does have a distinctive, but not unpleasant, temporary odor. The visible smoke and odor only lasts a few minutes, where ventilation is adequate.

To conduct the test, smoke will be introduced at specific sanitary sewer manholes located on the streets. During the test, personnel will conduct a visual observation along streets and around individual homes, for smoke exiting storm sewers, roof gutters, and other areas which may be connected to the sanitary sewer system.

Smoke should not enter your home unless the plumbing is defective or if your home contains drains which are infrequently used. Several days prior to 8/25/2025, please pour or run water down all drains in your home or building to assure that drain traps are filled and in working order.







Within these walls, our dad, Phil, instilled in his children the cherished values of community service and of conducting a reputable, small-town business, focusing intently on the need of his neighbors.

The Shurtleff family continues to provide such personal, reliable and well-established service to the area communities through the Shurtleff Funeral Homes located in Genoa and Groton.

At the Shurtleff Funeral Home, it is our purpose to celebrate and honor the legacies of not just our neighbors, but of all those we are called upon and privileged to serve. Constructed circa 1895 and known then as the "Goodyear Block," the brick building at 115 Main Street, Groton, has been inhabited by numerous enterprises over the past century and a quarter.

Dr. Miles D. Goodyear, the original owner, was a noted local physician. His family also owned adjacent properties, including the Groton Hotel. When Dr. Goodyear passed away in 1913, he bequeathed \$13,000 (that's over \$400,000 in today's dollars) to fund construction of the Goodyear Memorial Library (now the Groton Public Library) in honor of his mother.

In addition to the Post Office, occupants in the 20th century included the law offices of Stoddard & Chatterton, a variety store, Kostenbader's Jewelry and Optometry, Walt Hoerger's Photography Studio, and the Booth Company Furniture Store. It was also the original home of the Robert C. Dempsey Insurance.

The Groton Town Historical Association first located here in the early 1970's, prior to making its home at the "Old Baptist Meeting House," just down the street.

AND for over 30 years, Phil Shurtleff operated NEA Realty of Groton at this location, where from the front steps he routinely acknowledged passers-by with his familiar greeting of "hey neighbor!"

Today, Doug Houck is redeveloping the space for his musical endeavors with "Leisure Studios."


