



- Stabilize and grow Lansing's tax base
- Create hundreds of good-paying local jobs
- Support schools, first responders, and community programs
- Drive business to local restaurants, hotels, and shops
- Build partnerships with local schools and colleges
- Preserve Cayuga Lake, restore the skyline, and contribute new public access and conservation land

This is responsible redevelopment — turning the long idle industrial site into tomorrow's clean-energy hub.

What's Really at Risk

Lansing's budget is in crisis. Property taxes keep climbing, and basic public services are being scaled back.

Instead of presenting a long-term financial plan, town leadership is rushing to adopt a politically motivated moratorium that targets a single project. This process has raised serious questions about open-meeting compliance and closed-door decision-making that encouraged activist participation while excluding the general public.
